

City trees get treated for Emerald Ash Borer

Jeff Palmer, an arborist for Arborjet, provided a complementary treatment to prevent invasion by the Emerald Ash Borer for the five ash trees at the Wisconsin Dells Municipal Building, La Crosse Street, on Sept. 10.

Palmer also voluntarily advised members of the city's Tree Committee on the condition of the city's ash trees during a windshield inventory. He recommended many of city trees as candidates for treatment with Tree-age, the Arborjet product for control and the rest for cutting and replacement.

Although the Emerald Ash Borer has not been found in Wisconsin Dells, it has been found in Columbia and Sauk counties. The city's trees have been marked with a green dot on the street side of the tree.
